












Webster Animal Control

Leash Laws:


-  All dogs in Webster are subject to leash laws.
-  They must be contained and controlled at all times by the owner, on and off the property, and any destruction or damage is the responsibility of the owner.
-  All dogs must be equipped with a collar of sufficient strength to restrain the dog, to which is attached a leash of sufficient strength. Said leash shall be held by a person having the ability to control and restrain the dog by means of the collar or harness and leash. Said leash shall not be more than eight feet long. A harness worn by a guide dog for the blind shall be considered a suitable leash hereunder.

When To Call Animal Control:

-  To report a dog at large
-  To report an injured animal
-  To report a lost or found pet
-  To report dog attack or dangerous dog concern
-  To inquire for professional/educational information or guidance
-  To report a dog or owner not in compliance with a town ordinance(s)



Remember To Scoop The Poop!

-  Upon the deposit of waste by a dog or other domestic animal on the property of another person, the owner of such dog or animal shall remove the waste, and make proper disposal of that waste in a trash receptacle and not left or tossed into the woods/fields.
